

Immigration Advice Service Fee List (effective from 1st April 2021)

At Citizens Advice Bury & Bolton (CABB), we provide high quality advice services. We provide a low-cost, fee paying service for clients seeking further advice and casework with their immigration and asylum case. The service is available to those who are not eligible for Legal Aid.

All clients receive **FREE** initial advice and assessment. We charge on a fixed fee basis only. We are transparent about any costs in relation to the services we provide. This ensures that you can make an informed choice about using CABB to manage your case on your behalf. At CABB, we are proud that we are not a profit-making organisation. This means that our fees are consistently lower than many other providers.

What do our fees include?

- All attendance, written and telephone correspondence with client and relevant 3rd parties, including making representations to the Home Office on your behalf,
- Informing you of any developments as and when they arise,
- Consideration, preparation and submission of all necessary documentation (this includes time spent working on your case, inclusive of emails & telephone calls, to you and any third party in your case, e.g Home Office).
- Copies of documents and postage

You will be responsible for all Home Office application fees. Disbursements are charged in addition to our fees. Disbursements are costs relating to your matter which are payable to third parties. Disbursements commonly incurred in immigration matters include:

- Home Office and official fees which vary depending on the type of application you are making. You pay these to the Home Office directly as part of the application process, we may be able to support this. You can find a list of [Home Office fees here](#).
- Other expenses where applicable to your case, such as payments for medical/expert evidence/ barristers where required,
- Interpreter fees, which vary depending on your spoken language and the amount of time spent by the interpreter,
- Official translation fees. These can vary depending on the language and the number of documents requiring translation,
- We will let you know as soon as practically possible whether any costs apply and before any costs are incurred on your case.

Please note, should you wish to withdraw instructions part way through your case, we will charge you for all work we have undertaken on your behalf, to date, at an hourly rate of £75.
